

\$5,000 Spring Handicapping Challenge

Official Rules

1. **THE CONTEST:**
Using handicapping skills in Round 1A (Friday, April 25), Round 1B (Saturday, April 26), or Round 1C (Sunday, April 27) contest participants will attempt to select the most SHOW horses (officially finish first, second or third) in each of Hollywood Park races 3-8 on April 25 and/or April 26 and/or April 27. YOU MUST PARTICIPATE FRIDAY, APRIL 25, SATURDAY, APRIL 26 or SUNDAY, APRIL 27, 2008 TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ROUND TWO. Based on results of selections made, handicappers from Round 1A, Round 1B, or Round 1C will advance to the Second Round on Saturday, May 24, 2008. For the Second Round, each qualifying handicapper will be issued an official contest card in which handicappers must select the PLACE horses (officially finish first or second). Contestants that enter the Second Round will advance to the Third Round on Saturday, June 21, 2008. For the Third Round, each qualifying handicapper will be Issued an official contest card in which handicappers must select the WIN horses (officially finish first).
2. **TO ENTER:**
Obtain an official Hollywood Park Spring Handicapping Challenge Contest Card and READ THE DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY. Contest cards for the First Round on Friday, April 25 through Sunday, April 27, 2008 will be available at Hollywood Park with admission. Print your name, address, zip code and date of birth in the spaces provided. Check the box corresponding to the date you are entering. YOU MUST COMPLETE THIS PORTION OF THE CONTEST CARD FOR YOUR ENTRY TO BE CONSIDERED VALID. Entries for the 2008 Spring Handicapping Challenge may not be deposited by mail and must be deposited at a Contest Central location prior to 5 minutes before post time of the 3rd Hollywood Park race on each day of the First Round.
3. **CONTEST ENTRIES:**
AFTER CAREFULLY READING THE DIRECTIONS ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE CONTEST CARD, place selections for each of the live Hollywood Park races 3-8 carded for Friday, April 25 or Saturday, April 26 or Sunday, April 27. Then deposit contest cards at a Contest Central location by the official deadline of 5 minute before the post time of the third race. Hollywood Park will not be held responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced cards.
4. **MAKING A SELECTION:**
Enter your selections from the Hollywood Park Daily Program for the qualifying rounds on Friday, April 25 through Sunday, April 27, 2008. Place your selections in the spaces provided. You may select only one horse for each of the six races. For purposes of this contest, horses grouped in an entry or mutual field will be considered one horse. You may not select more than one horse in each race. Any contest card that violates any of the aforementioned will be disqualified.
5. **DEADLINE TO ENTER:**
The deadline for depositing cards for Round 1A - 1C 5 minutes prior to post time of the third Hollywood Park race of each corresponding day. The official time used for purposes of this deadline will be the time displayed on the Hollywood Park Totalisator boards. The deadline for depositing contest cards for the Second Round is exactly 5 minutes prior to post time of the third Hollywood Park race, on Saturday, May 24, 2008. The deadline for depositing contest cards for the Third Round is exactly 5 minutes prior to post time of the third Hollywood Park race, on Saturday, June 21, 2008. Contest cards may only be deposited at an official Contest Central location.
6. **GRADING OF CONTEST ENTRIES:**
All rounds are independent, and no scores are carried forward. Each round, including the FINAL ROUND, begins with all entrants having equal score. REMEMBER: PROGRAM NUMBERS DERIVED FROM ANY SOURCE OTHER THAN THE HOLLYWOOD PARK DAILY PROGRAM ARE UNOFFICIAL AND MAY NOT BE CORRECT.
7. **ROUND TWO AND THREE CONTESTANTS:**
All persons eligible for Round Two will be notified by mail. Those notified will receive one coupon good for free General Admission valid only Saturday, May 24, 2008 and an official Round Two contest card. All persons eligible for Round Three will be notified by mail. Those notified will receive one coupon good for free General Admission valid on Saturday, June 21, 2008 and an official Round Three contest card. Any contestant submitting more than one card for Round Two or Three will be disqualified. Contestants should retain the contest cards that are mailed to them for the Second and Third Round. No other card will be qualified for Round Two or Three. Additional or replacement contest cards for lost or stolen contest cards will not be available. Hollywood Park assumes no responsibility for lost, late or undeliverable mail. Entries may not be deposited by mail.
8. **ROUND TWO ENTRIES:**
Round Two, requirements for selections for the racing card of Saturday, May 24, 2008, will be conducted under the same rules as Round One, with the exception of the format for selections. Contestants are to select horses to Place in races 3 through 8. The person whose mythical \$2 place wagers earn the most mythical money on Saturday, May 24 will win a Big Screen Plasma TV.

9. **FINAL ROUND ENTRIES:**
Round Three, requirements for selections for the racing card of Saturday, June 21, 2007, will be conducted under the same rules as Round One and Two, with the exception of the format for selections. Contestants are to select horses to Win in races 3 through 8. The top three persons whose mythical \$2 Win wagers earn the most mythical money on Saturday, June 23 will share \$5,000.
10. **OFFICIAL CONTEST ENTRIES:**
Only official Contest Cards are valid. Any reproductions of any kind, facsimiles, Xerox copies or pieces altered in any way from their original condition will be disqualified.
11. **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY:**
There is no charge for entry, prize winning or participation in any phase of this contest. Those wishing to enter the contest without paying admission can obtain a contest card at the Will Call window. Contest cards for Round One are available free of charge and with each paid admission on Friday, April 25 through Sunday, April 27, 2008. Contest cards for Round One may be deposited at Contest Central booths located throughout Hollywood Park on Friday, April 25 through Sunday, April 27, 2008. This contest is void where prohibited by law.
12. **SCRATCHES:**
For purposes of this contest, any selection that is scratched after an entry is deposited in an official contest box will be automatically transferred to the post time favorite. Selections will automatically become the actual betting favorite for that race, as established by the public in the win pool. Cards showing more than one selection for any race will be immediately rejected and disqualified.
13. **PRIZES:**
In Round 2, the handicapper whose mythical \$2.00 Place wagers earn the most mythical money will win a Plasma TV. In the event of a tie, the prize will be awarded to the handicapper with the largest payoff based on a mythical \$2 WIN wager on each correct selection. In the event of a further tie, a winner will be randomly drawn by Hollywood Park Management. In no event will multiple prizes be awarded for Round 2. In Round 3, the top three handicappers whose mythical \$2.00 Win wagers earn the most mythical money will share \$5,000. Prizes for the Final Round are: First Prize \$3,250, Second Prize is \$1,250, Third Prize is \$500. In the event of a tie, the prize money will be split equally among the winners.
14. **REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTESTANTS:**
Entrants must be 18 years of age or older. Liability for any and all federal, state and local taxes rests solely with the prize winners. Affidavits will be required of all prize winners confirming compliance with the rules of this contest.
15. **TIES:**
If for any reason there exists a tie between one or more contestant in any phase of this contest, and any such tie has not been previously covered by these official rules, Hollywood Park Racing Association reserves the right to resolve all such ties without claim for damages or recourse of any kind.
16. **LEGIBILITY:**
Hollywood Park Racing Association assumes no responsibility for cards deemed illegible by contest officials. PRINT YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, ZIP CODE, PHONE, BIRTHDATE AND ALL WAGERING SELECTIONS CLEARLY.
17. **AFFIDAVITS:**
Affidavits confirming compliance of all rules of this contest will be required of all Finalists and Prize Winners. Winning persons acknowledge that if they enter this contest under a fraudulent name and/or Social Security number, they will be immediately disqualified from this and all future contests at Hollywood Park. Positive Identification is required of all prize winners. (Positive identification is a valid California Driver's License with a picture and the same address and birth date used on contest cards, and/or such other form of identification as deemed adequate by contest officials.)
18. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:**
In the event that a finalist is disqualified for any reason, any prize money won by that finalist will be forfeited.
19. **INELIGIBILITY:**
The following are ineligible to participate in this contest: employees of Hollywood Park Racing Association or any of their subsidiaries; employees of their advertising agencies or public relations consultants; members of the media, horsemen, backstretch personnel, vendors or any individual credentialed by or Hollywood Park or the California Horse Racing Board, or members of the immediate families, including spouses, children, siblings and parents of any of the foregoing.
20. **JUDGING AND DISPUTES:**
The management of Hollywood Park Racing Association reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to this event, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions and definitions not covered explicitly in these rules will be decided by the management of Hollywood Park Racing Association, with those decisions to be final. Winners will be posted around the track and notified by mail and/or over the phone if prize is not claimed within one week of the finals.
